### QUILT SHOW RULES & GUIDELINES

#### Who can enter?

1. EDQG members who have paid a 2024-25 regular or senior membership fee, are a 2024-25 Silver Thimble member, or a Honourary (Life) member are eligible to enter the Festival.
2. Youth 17 years and younger as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025, who are sponsored by an EDQG member. These will not be judged. Exhibit only.
3. Groups of 3 or more EDQG members, all of whom are eligible EDQG members (see item 1.) These will not be judged. Exhibit only.
4. EDQG Student Member – Student Members are in full-time attendance at an educational institution and have paid the membership fee.

#### How many quilts may be entered?

1. Individuals are allowed 4 entries. (Judged and/or Exhibit Only)  
(If there are too many quilts for judging, your last quilt may be moved to the non-judged (exhibit only) category.)
2. Youth may enter one quilt. Exhibit only.
3. Groups may enter one quilt, but an individual may be a member of more than one group. A group is comprised of 3 or more EDQG members. Exhibit only.
4. The Prairie Rose Quilt Show is a separate “show within a show” with those entries being sent to the Past Chair of the EDQG.

#### Which quilts can be entered?

Any quilt completed after May 30, 2023, and not entered in the 2023 quilt show may be entered into this show.

#### Additional Important Information

1. Items must be quilted (3 layers held together by stitching). Exceptions will apply in the 2 following categories which must have a minimum of 2 layers connected with quilting.
  - Category TW Three Dimensional Items
  - Category SQ Wearables Only
2. Traditional hanging sleeves (4 inches in depth) are required. Large quilts may require a second hanging sleeve. Committee will contact maker should this be required. Wearables do not require a hanging sleeve.
3. Items in the category Art Quilts may require a different method of hanging due to size, shape, etc. Committee will contact entrant to discuss the requirement.
4. Items must be clean, i.e. free of lint & pet hair and in good condition.
5. The Registrars reserve the right to determine the final placement of quilts into categories and may combine or divide categories if needed. Entrants will be consulted before any changes are made.
